



# Ruff Stuff and Scuff & Prep Paste

## 6337, 6338

Scuff & Prep Paste and Ruff Stuff are used for paint preparation and blending. Use for surface preparation prior to painting to remove contaminants, silicone, grease and oils, tar and road film. Use on all areas to be painted, panels, jambs, moldings, bumpers. To save time, use in place of wet sanding and degreasing. Use Scuff & Prep Paste for light scuffing and Ruff Stuff for heavy scuff applications.

- Raw plastic - rigid (SMC, BMC)
- Raw plastic - flex (ABD, PPO)
- Raw plastic - soft (PUR)
- Plastic part - primed
- Fiberglass/SMC Gel Coat
- Bare steel
- Bare galvanized
- Bare aluminum
- Self-etch primer
- All OEM finish & old paint work
- 1K primer
- 2K primer
- Body filler
- OEM E-Coat

*Note: Due to the diverse nature of plastics, always test plastic substrate for acceptable adhesion. Adhesion promoter maybe required for proper adhesion.*

*Note: Test pre-primed panels with acetone or paint thinner. If coating fails, strip panel to bare plastic & follow SOP 251 for Raw Plastic.*



### Surface Prep & Application

Wash application area with warm water & soap prior to use. Apply Scuff & Prep Paste or Ruff Stuff to clean, wet, green/grey fine abrasive pad, cloth, or foam pad. Use circular motion and light pressure. For confined areas use a stiff brush. Rinse area off with clean water.

Note: Remember to rinse clean with water to remove any residue prior to degreasing.
